#### **DECLARATION OF JONATHAN GROSSMAN**

# I, Jonathan Grossman, declare:

I am a staff attorney with the Sixth District Appellate Program representing A.A. on appeal. He is appealing a judgment following a contested jurisdictional hearing where he was found to have possessed a firearm in violation of Penal Code section 12021, subdivision (a). (See CT 288-292.)

An issue at the contested jurisdictional hearing was whether appellant threw an object, believed to be a gun, from a car when the police were pursuing it. The incident was recorded by a video camera attached to the front of the police car. A DVD of the video was admitted as People's Exhibit 1. (2RT 39-42, 44.)

At present, the exhibit is located at the Superior Court in Hollister. A trip to the Superior Court will be time consuming and will result in substantial expense to the state. Since my office is located in relatively close proximity to this court, it would be far less expensive were I to travel only to this court in order to examine the exhibit. Given these circumstances, I would respectfully request that the exhibit be promptly transmitted to this court.
