I, Jonathan Grossman, declare:

1. I am a staff attorney for Sixth District Appellate Program. which has been appointed to represent appellant Mario Salazar. I handled the appeal as a staff case.

2. Good cause exists for the requested authorization for translator fees because:

a. Appellant speaks and is literate in Spanish; he does not speak or read and write in English. He was appointed a Spanish interpreter in the trial court.
